

**Title V Extended Service Funds
Approved Services
Eligibility Guidelines**

The extended service funds are designed for use by families of children with chronic health care needs who require services of a type or amount not required by same-age peers without chronic illness. The chronic condition must have lasted or is anticipated to last at least 12 months. This program is designed to assist the uninsured or underinsured families.

Specifically, the requirements are:

- Enrollment at the Regional Center – meets (+) criteria from Screener
- Family income between 200 and 300% of the Federal Poverty Level (see Table)
- Family can't be eligible for Husky or Medicaid programs (including waivers)
- Family must furnish prescription for item (if needed), quote from vendor (if needed) and denial from private insurance plan
- Paid at the Medicaid rate
- Child must be State of Connecticut resident through age 21
